<u>General Program Referrals:</u> Submit a completed Program Referral Form to: FCJC.ProgramReferrals@fultoncountyga.gov.

Evidence Based Program Referrals:

A referral for Evidence-Based Program (EBP) follows the same process as all Fulton County Juvenile Court program referrals. However, if a referral is submitted for a youth who does not meet all EBP requirements, a Special Consideration Form must be completed and submitted with the referral and supporting referral documents.*

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



Evidence-Based Programs

Aggression Replacement Training (ART)

ART is a research-based, proven-effective approach for working with challenging youth. ART features three coordinated and integrated components: (1) Social Skills Training: teaches participants what to do, helping them replace antisocial behaviors with positive alternatives. (2) Anger Control: teaches participants what not to do, helping them respond to anger in a nonaggressive manner and rethink anger-provoking situations. (3) Moral Reasoning: helps raise participants' level of fairness, justice and concern for the needs and rights of others.

Family Functional Therapy (FFT)

FFT is an evidence-based intervention for youth and families. The high-quality, strengthfocused counseling model is designed primarily for at-risk youth who have been referred by the juvenile justice, mental health, school or child welfare systems. Services are short term and conducted in both clinic and home settings and can also be provided in schools, child welfare facilities, probation and parole systems and mental health facilities.

<u>Multisystemic Therapy (MST)</u>

MST is an intensive family and community-based treatment that focuses on addressing all environmental systems that impact chronic juvenile offenders—their homes and families, schools and teachers, neighborhoods and friends. MST recognizes that each system plays a critical role in a youth's world and each system requires attention when effective change is needed to improve the quality of life for youth and their families. Sessions generally occur a minimum of two times per week for approximately 4 months and includes sessions for both parent and youth.

Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT)

TF-CBT is a therapeutic intervention designed to help children, adolescents and their parents overcome the impact of traumatic events. The focus of treatment is to assist the child or adolescent to develop coping strategies for traumatic stress reactions, and reduce symptoms of depression, anxiety, or acting out behavior which are common in children exposed to trauma. Sessions generally occur a minimum of two times per week for approximately 4 months and include sessions for both parent and youth.



PROGRAM OVERVIEW

ASCEND is a 10–12 month Accountability Court structured program that focuses on youth who have been adjudicated for a Class A or B Felony offense or are at risk for commitment to the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ). Through a judicially managed, team-based approach, ASCEND will provide evidence-based programming in an effort to reduce the number of youth committed to DJJ or secure confinement.

Evidence-Based Program (EBP). An EBP is an approach to treatment that has been scientifically proven to work. A program that "works" in juvenile justice can reduce crime, delinquency, family conflict, substance use, academic failure, and behavior problems. Youth may be referred to Aggression Replacement Training (ART) or another EBP as part of their participation in ASCEND.

VISION STATEMENT

Fulton County Juvenile Court seeks to reduce recidivism and foster rehabilitation amongst high-risk youth in the community through the implementation of EBP's, facilitated in an accountability court model.

PROGRAM PURPOSE

The purpose of ASCEND is to provide intensive and judicially monitored evidence-based programs structured to divert youth, identified as high risk from commitment to DJJ or secure confinement.

Fulton County Juvenile Drug Court DRUGS C.H.O.I.C.E.S PROGRAM Choosing Healthy Options Increases Confidence, Excellence and Success

Drug courts integrate alcohol and other evidence-based treatment services with juvenile justice case processing.

C.H.O.I.C.E.S is a highly structured, non-adversarial, team-based approach, 12 – 15 month voluntary intervention program for moderate to high-risk youth, who have been assessed to have a substance use disorder and/or be dependent upon alcohol. C.H.O.I.C.E.S strives to reduce substance use and recidivism of participants through evidence-based individual, family, and group interventions and treatment.

<u>Program Eligibility</u>: Youth who meet the following criteria should be referred to drug court: (A youth does not have to meet all criteria to be referred)

- 14 17 years of age
- Resident of Fulton County
- YASI score of medium to high risk for substance use
- PDRA score of medium to high risk for substance use
- Self-report or parent report of substance use
- Drug related offenses
- Multiple positive drug screens

Youth with significant mental health disorders, significant developmental delays or those with chronic or terminal medical conditions are not good candidates for juvenile drug court.

Fulton County Family Treatment Court H.O.P.E.

Helping Our Parents Excel

Family Treatment Court (FTC) integrates substance use treatment services with dependency/child welfare/child abuse and neglect case processing for parents and/or legal guardians who have been assessed to have a substance use disorder.

H.O.P.E. is an 18–24 months, four (4) phase and Aftercare Accountability Court Program that strives to promote the health, safety and welfare of children by actively intervening to treat substance use disorder by providing evidence-based services and utilizing a collaborative multidisciplinary team and judicially managed approach.

Eligibility:

<u>Cases</u>:

- Family Preservation Cases, wherein parental substance use is the primary cause of the alleged neglect of a child.
- Protective Order Cases, wherein parental substance use is the primary cause of the alleged neglect of a child.
- Post adjudication/disposition cases, wherein parental substance use is the primary cause of the alleged neglect of a child.
- Permanency Plan includes goal of reunification.

Cases alleging serious child abuse and domestic violence are not eligible for FTC.

<u>Individuals</u>: The H.O.P.E Program is designed for parents and legal guardians who meet the following criteria:

- A resident of Fulton County, Georgia;
- Have an open DFCS or Family Preservation case;
- Have a dependency allegation arising from substance use and/or dependency
- No current filed or pending Termination of Parental Rights (TPR)
- No current court findings of physical abuse
- No prior substantiated reports for sexual abuse
